These at-home group projects are perfect for 25-1000 volunteers and will bring your employees together through virtual volunteer programs or as part of an in-person group activity. These projects support nonprofit partners who are working on the ground in Haiti.

Disaster Relief, Recovery, and Preparedness

By participating, you and your colleagues can help those impacted by both the 7.2 magnitude earthquake that hit Haiti in August and Tropical Storm Grace, which followed soon after. Each packed kit will be distributed by nonprofits that are working in partnership with the U.S. Southern Command's

partnership with the U.S. Southern Command's Public Private Cooperation. Kits are not only needed for immediate response, but in preparation for future natural disasters.

Kit Options:

Emergency Hygiene Kits: 5 hygiene kits (i.e. toothpaste, toothbrush, soap, deodorant, First Aid Kit, washcloth, body wash, feminine pads) \$100 / kit

School Supply Kits: 5 education kits (i.e. crayons, pencils, zipper pouch, sharpener, notebook, scissors, ruler, cinch sack) \$110 / kit

*Kits include shipping to individual homes or to a group activity and forward shipping to the nonprofit recipient.
